



Carolina Soccer Club Fee Assistance Program Policy

Carolina Soccer Club (CRSC) is committed to providing a high-quality, affordable youth soccer program that is accessible to everyone. Therefore, financial assistance may be available to families demonstrating financial need through our Fee-Assistance Program (FAP). It is intended as a financial assistance program for those applicants and families requiring temporary or permanent assistance for the period to be established by the fee-assistance committee which may not exceed one year, after which time the applicant and their family will need to reapply for assistance.

Guidelines/Policies

1. Carolina Soccer Club will maintain a Fee Assistance Fund. The purpose of the fund is to support players who may need financial assistance to play soccer for Carolina Soccer Club. All fee assistance is need based rather than player ability based.
2. Fee assistance will be awarded based on qualification criteria set by the Fee Assistance Committee. Qualification criteria will include gross monthly income, family size, and may include other criteria.
3. Upon review of applicant package, the Fee Assistance Committee sends its recommendations to the executive board for confirmation.
4. Carolina Soccer Club will not grant 100% fee assistance. Carolina Soccer Club feels it is necessary for the applicant and their family to maintain some financial involvement to ensure the appropriate level of focus and commitment to the club throughout the season.
5. The applicant and their family are responsible for all expenses not covered by the fee assistance award. Fee assistance awards may only be applied towards club training fees for classic players. TADL/Challenge player's fee assistance may be awarded for a portion of the registration fee. Individual team fees; including tournaments fees, uniforms and other related team expenses are the sole responsibility of the player unless otherwise stated in the fee assistance award letter.
6. Funds are limited and completion of a fee assistance application does not guarantee a fee-assistance award. The Fee Assistance Committee may cancel fee assistance awards at any time.
7. After all qualified applicants are awarded fee assistance, any remaining fee assistance monies shall continue to be held for future fee assistance use unless explicitly repurposed by the Board. Funds donated to the club, or monies raised specifically for the purpose of fee assistance, cannot be repurposed.

8. Fee assistance application forms will be available at tryouts, team registration, on the Carolina Soccer Club website and upon request from the CRSC administrative offices. Fee assistance applications, along with all supporting documentation, should be hand-delivered or mailed to: Carolina Soccer Club, Attn: Fee Assistance Committee, 6013 Hillsborough Street, Raleigh, NC 27606. A fee assistance application package must be submitted in order to be considered for a fee assistance award.

9. The Fee Assistance Committee's response to each application will be communicated in writing to the applicant. All information submitted is confidential and will only be available to the Fee Assistance Committee and office staff and used solely to determine eligibility for fee assistance and for no other purposes.
